

the Council the Permit (unless already surrendered to the Registration Authority by whom it was issued) and the Registration Card issued to him under the Regulation of the Minister of Transport ;

- (c) The Council shall advise the London County Council and the Registration Authority by whom the Permit was issued (if the Permit were not issued by the London County Council) of the receipt of the Permit, if received by them, and the issue of such licence by them ;
- (d) The identification mark to be assigned by the Council shall, if the person making application in pursuance of this Regulation so desire, be the identification mark of the vehicle under the Regulations of the Minister of Transport : Provided that at the expiration of one year from the date upon which the vehicle was last brought into Northern Ireland such identification mark shall become void and the Council shall assign a new identification mark in accordance with the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1947.

4. Nothing in these Regulations shall apply to any person bringing a motor vehicle into Northern Ireland from Eire who complies with the provisions of the Motor Car (Irish Circulation) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1925 (a).

5. The Interpretation Act, 1889 (b), applies for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

### Registration and Licensing.

REGULATIONS, DATED 4TH DECEMBER, 1948, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER SECTION 12 OF THE ROADS ACT, 1920.

1948. No. 317

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under or by virtue of Section 12 of the Roads

Act, 1920 (a), the Ministries Act (Northern Ireland), 1944 (b), and the Ministries (Transfer of Functions) (No. 3) Order, 1944 (c), hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as “The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948.”

(2) In these Regulations :—

The expression “Principal Regulations” means “The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1947” (d), which make provision, amongst other things, for the registration of mechanically-propelled vehicles and for the allotting to each of the Councils mentioned in the first column of the Fourth Schedule thereto, of the Index Mark or Index Marks shown opposite to the name of that Council in the second column of the said Schedule.

2. The Principal Regulations shall have effect as though the Schedule to these Regulations were substituted for the Fourth Schedule thereto.

3. The Interpretation Act, 1921 (e), applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
