- 6.—(1) Any adjustment relating to the property, assets, rights or liabilities of a transferor or to services to be provided by a transferor consequent upon the transfer of functions by this Order shall be the subject of agreements to be entered into by the transferor and the transferee, with the approval of the Ministry.
- (2) In default of agreement as aforesaid in relation to any adjustment which either a transferor or a transferee deems necessary in consequence of the transfer of functions by this Order the matter in dispute shall be determined by the Ministry.
- 7. The provisions of section thirteen of the Act shall, as from the appointed day, extend and be applicable to any person designated by the transferee and employed immediately before the appointed day by a transferor partly for the purposes of the functions transferred by this Order and partly for other purposes:

Provided that this Article shall, if the transferee so determines and the Ministry approves, apply the provisions of the said section thirteen to the whole of the employment of that person for the purposes of any of the functions of the transferor transferable to the transferee under the Act.
