ORDER, DATED 31ST DECEMBER, 1948, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION ONE OF THE FIRE SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) (REPRINT), 1947.

The Ministry of Home Affairs by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section One of the Fire Services Act (Northern Ireland) (Reprint), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Fire Services (Belfast Fire District and Fire Authority) Order (Northern Ireland), 1948.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

(3) This Order shall have effect as from the first day of April, 1949.

2. The County Borough of Belfast shall comprise the Fire District to be called the Belfast Fire District.

3. The Fire Authority for the Belfast Fire District shall be the Council of the County Borough of Belfast.

4. The Fire Services (Belfast Fire District and Fire Authority) Order (Northern Ireland), 1947, is hereby revoked.
