WHEREAS the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") has received from the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) wages regulation proposals for the amendment of the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (No. 5) Order, 1948 (a) dated the 3rd day of August, 1948, (hereinafter referred to as "Order N.I.Bk. (66)") which fixes the minimum remuneration to be paid to certain workers in relation to whom the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) operates;

Baking

1. As from the specified date Order N.I.Bk. (66) shall have effect Statutory minimum resubject to the amendments set out in the Schedule to this Order.

2. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the Commence-27th day of December, 1948. Provided that where, as respects any ^{ment.} worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date.

3.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Baking Wages Council Short title (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, pretation. 1948.
