

Housing Subsidy Order

ORDER, DATED 29TH JUNE, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION ONE OF THE HOUSING (NO. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section one of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of every other power it thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. In the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1946 (a), as amended by the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1947 (b), and the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1948 (c), (which provides for the number and amount of contributions payable—

- (a) by the Ministry to a local authority under section one of the Housing Act (Northern Ireland), 1945 (in this Order referred to as "the Act of 1945");
- (b) by a local authority to the credit of their Housing Revenue Account under section two of the Act of 1945;
- (c) by the Ministry to the Northern Ireland Housing Trust under subsections (1) and (2) of section sixteen of the Act of 1945; or
- (d) by the Ministry to a housing association under the said section one of the Act of 1945 as applied to housing associations by virtue of section twelve of the Housing and Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946),

for the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and forty-nine" where they appear in the said Order there shall be substituted the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and fifty."

2. The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply to the interpretation of this Order in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. This Order may be cited as the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1949.

Death Certificates

REGULATIONS, DATED 21ST JUNE, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER PARAGRAPH 5 OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE TO THE INDUSTRIAL ASSURANCE AND FRIENDLY SOCIETIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

The Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by paragraph 5 of the First Schedule to the Industrial Assurance and Friendly Societies Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Industrial Assurance and Friendly Societies (Death Certificates) Regulations, (Northern Ireland), 1949, and shall come into operation on the 5th day of July, 1949.

2.—(1) In these regulations —

“ the Act ” means the Industrial Assurance and Friendly Societies Act (Northern Ireland), 1948 ;

“ death certificate ” means a certificate of a death issued for the purposes of the First Schedule to the Act ;

“ the Registrar-General ” means the Registrar-General for Northern Ireland ;

“ registration officer ” in relation to a death certificate or an application therefor, means the superintendent registrar or registrar of births and deaths having the custody for the time being of the register book in which the death to which the certificate or application relates is entered.
