

26. * Fee for special treatment provided or supplied under Part V of the Health Services (General Dental Services) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948, which, in the opinion of the Dental Estimates Committee, is required by the patient owing solely to his clinical condition, or any repair of a denture supplied as part of such treatment so required. Such fee as the Dental Estimates Committee may determine in accordance with a scale approved by the Ministry.
- * Treatment for which the prior approval of the Dental Estimates Committee is required, except that—
- (a) extractions not necessitating the supply of dentures;
 - (b) treatment for relief of pain or other urgent symptoms;
 - (c) radiological examination up to a fee of 12s. 6d. for intra-oral films or 15s. 6d. for an extra-oral film; and
 - (d) repairs to metal dentures at a cost not exceeding £1 15s. 0d. may be carried out without prior approval.

General Scheme : Modification

ORDER, DATED 30TH SEPTEMBER, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER SECTION TWENTY-EIGHT OF THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

WHEREAS sub-section (4) of section twenty-eight of the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland), 1948, provides that the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority (in this Order referred to as "the Authority") may from time to time, after consultation with the Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland (in this Order

referred to as "the Ministry"), adopt a new general scheme providing for the modification of the general scheme for the time being in force :

AND WHEREAS the Authority has adopted and submitted to the Ministry a new general scheme providing for the modification of the general schemes adopted by the Authority on the 13th day of May, 1948, and the 9th day of November, 1948, and approved (with modifications) by the Ministry by Orders dated the 31st day of May, 1948 (a), and 31st day of December, 1948 (b) ;

AND WHEREAS the Ministry thinks fit to approve the said new general scheme ;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry hereby approves the new general scheme set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

NEW GENERAL SCHEME MADE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE HEALTH SERVICES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1948.

1. In this scheme, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them, that is to say —

"the Act" means the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948 ;

"the Authority" means the Northern Ireland Hospitals Authority ;

"the Ministry" means the Ministry of Health and Local Government ;

"the General Scheme" means the General Scheme under the provisions of sub-section (1) of section twenty-eight of the Act adopted by the Authority on the thirteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight and approved by the Ministry by an Order made under the Act on the thirty-first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and as modified by a New General Scheme made under the provisions

of the said section of the Act adopted by the Authority on the ninth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, and approved by the Ministry by an Order made under the Act on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.

2. WHEREAS it is provided in section twenty-eight of the Act that the Authority may from time to time after consultation with the Ministry adopt a new General Scheme or Schemes providing for the modification of any General Scheme or Schemes under section twenty-eight of the Act for the time being in force.

3. AND WHEREAS the Authority having consulted the Ministry, consider it is proper and expedient to adopt a further New General Scheme providing for the modification of the said General Scheme.

4. AND WHEREAS the Authority have decided that the hospital unit situated adjacent to the Waveney Hospital at Ballymena, in the County of Antrim, commonly known as the Belfast Auxiliary Hospital, Ballymena, and at present administered by the South Belfast Hospital Management Committee as a unit of the Belfast City Hospital shall now constitute a separate hospital to be named the Braid Valley Hospital, and the remainder of the building in which that unit is situated and which is being adapted for use as a hospital shall be treated as part of the Braid Valley Hospital.

5. NOW THEREFORE the Authority in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-section (4) of section twenty-eight of the Act hereby adopt the following New General Scheme providing for the modification of the said General Scheme, that is to say —

NEW GENERAL SCHEME

The name of the Braid Valley Hospital shall be inserted opposite the name of the Mid-Antrim Hospital Management Committee in the said General Scheme and the Mid-Antrim Hospital Management Committee shall manage and control the Hospital, as from the first day of October, 1949.

6. The General Scheme as modified by the New General Scheme made and adopted by the Authority as aforesaid under the provisions of section twenty-eight of the Act shall be read and shall operate as modified by this further New General Scheme.
