1. The Control of Fertilisers (Northern Ireland) Order, 1946 (a), (which controls the production, distribution, acquisition and disposal of fertilisers) is hereby revoked.

2. This Order may be cited as the Control of Fertilisers (Revocation) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1949, and shall come into operation on the twenty-third day of March, 1949.

THE WASTE OF FUEL (REVOCATION) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1949, DATED 15TH NOVEMBER, 1949, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER REGULATION 55 OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers delegated to it under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945 (b) as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) Act, 1947 (c), hereby orders as follows :—

1. The Waste of Fuel (Northern Ireland) Order, 1942 (d), the Waste of Fuel (Northern Ireland) Order, 1943 (e), as amended by the Control of Fuel (Restriction of Heating) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1947 (f), and the Control of Fuel (Restriction of Heating) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1947, are hereby revoked.

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**THE FURNITURE (UTILITY MARK) (NORTHERN IRELAND)  
ORDER, 1949**

1949 No. 47

In exercise of the powers under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945 (a), as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) Act, 1947 (b), delegated to it by an Instrument of Delegation dated the 2nd day of July, 1946, made by the Board of Trade under the said Regulations, as having effect as aforesaid, and of all other powers it enabling, the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) No person shall apply the mark shown in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as the "utility mark") to furniture of any description other than—

- (a) furniture of a description specified in the First Schedule hereto; and
- (b) furniture of a description specified in any licence issued under Article 2 of the Furniture (Control of Manufacture and Supply) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1945 (c), as amended by any subsequent Order, to a manufacturer, being furniture in respect of the manufacture and supply of which only one manufacturer was so licensed.

(2) No person shall apply the utility mark to furniture of a description referred to in sub-paragraph (a) or sub-paragraph (b) of the preceding paragraph except under the authority of a licence issued by the Ministry under this paragraph and in accordance with any condition attached thereto.
