consumption in any controlled premises shall be 40 cwt.; so however that of such 40 cwt. aforesaid not more than 20 cwt. shall be furnished or acquired during the period of six months beginning on the 1st day of May, 1949, and ending on the 31st day of October, 1949 (both inclusive):

Provided that no fuel specified in this Article shall be furnished or acquired (whether or not for a consideration) for actual consumption in controlled premises except with the written authority of the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland.

3. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say :---

"Controlled Premises " means any premises in Northern Ireland in which coal is or is to be consumed other than the premises of a gas, electricity or railway undertaking, or of an industrial undertaking ;

" Coal " includes bituminous coal and cannel coal but excludes coke, coke breeze, anthracite, phurnod and manufactured fuel;

"Manufactured fuel " includes any manufactured fuel of which coal, anthracite, phurnod or coke is the principal constituent but excludes household coal briquettes.

(2) This Order may be cited as the Coal Supply (Temporary Provisions) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1949.
