ORDER, DATED 31ST AUGUST, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION ELEVEN OF THE POULTRY HATCHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

WHEREAS by Section Eleven of the Poultry Hatcheries Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into operation on such day as the Ministry shall by order appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry hereby appoints the first day of September, 1950, to be the date on which the Act shall come into operation.

REGULATIONS, DATED 5TH SEPTEMBER, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE POULTRY HATCHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

1950. No. 152

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Poultry Hatcheries Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation, Interpretation and Commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Poultry Hatcheries Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950.

(2) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:—

“accredited poultry farm” means a farm approved by the Ministry under its Scheme for the Accreditation of Poultry Farms under Section 9 of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland), 1949 in operation for the time being;

“Ministry” means the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland;

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1889, applies for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

(4) These Regulations shall come into operation on the date hereof.
