

ORDER, DATED 26TH SEPTEMBER, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION TEN OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section ten of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judges and the Resident Magistrates concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows :—

As and from the 1st day of December, 1950, the times when Petty Sessions shall be regularly held in the districts set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Order shall be as set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite the name of each of such Petty Sessions Districts and the Order made by the Ministry of Home Affairs on the 29th January, 1946, shall have effect accordingly.
