REGULATIONS, DATED 29TH SEPTEMBER, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SUB-SECTION (3) OF SECTION ELEVEN OF THE PROBATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

The Ministry of Home Affairs (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (3) of Section eleven of the Probation Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Probation (Payments by Probationers) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1950.

2. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

3. Every person who is required by a probation order to reside in an institution or place and who is employed outside the institution or place or awaiting such employment shall pay towards the cost of his maintenance such contributions as shall be determined by the Ministry having regard to such cost and to his ability to make a reasonable contribution towards the same.

4. The contributions required by the last preceding Regulation shall be paid to the managers of the institution or place at such times as the Ministry may in each case determine.

5. Any sum due under these Regulations to be paid to the managers of an institution or place shall be recoverable summarily as a civil debt.
