STATUTORY MINIMUM REMUNERATION FOR MALE WORKERS EMPLOYED IN AREA A, that is, IN ESTABLISHMENTS (OTHER THAN HOME BAKERIES) IN THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF THE CITY OF BELFAST AND IN DISTRICTS SITUATE WITHIN A RADIUS OF 15 STATUTE MILES THEREFROM.

Order N.I.Bk. (89), as amended, shall have effect as if in paragraph 2 of the Schedule thereto the words "nor in the calculation of holiday remuneration" were deleted.

WHEREAS the Ministry of Labour and National Insurance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") has received from the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) wages regulation proposals for the further amendment of the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (No. 3) Order, 1949 (a) (hereinafter referred to as "Order N.I. Bk. (91)") dated the 4th day of April, 1949, as amended by the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1949 (b) dated the 13th day of June, 1949, which fixes the minimum remuneration to be paid to certain workers in relation to whom the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) operates ;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry by virtue of section 10 of the Wages Councils Act (Northern Ireland), 1945 and of every other power in that behalf hereby makes the following Order :—

1. As from the specified date Order N.I.Bk. (91) as amended shall have effect subject to the further amendment set out in the Schedule to this Order. Statutory minimum remuneration.

2. In this Order the expression "the specified date" means the 6th day of January, 1950. Provided that where, as respects any worker who is paid wages at intervals not exceeding seven days, that date does not correspond with the beginning of the period for which the wages are paid, the expression "the specified date" means, as respects that worker, the beginning of the next such period following that date. Commencement.

3.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Baking Wages Council (Northern Ireland) Wages Regulation (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1950. Short title and interpretation.
