

**Classification Amendment Regulations
(Northern Ireland), 1950**

REGULATIONS, DATED 7TH FEBRUARY, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND NATIONAL INSURANCE, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE NATIONAL INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Labour and National Insurance, in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations :—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the National Insurance (Classification) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950, shall be read as one with the National Insurance (Classification) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") and shall come into operation on the 7th February, 1950.

Addition to the principal regulations

2. After regulation 5 of the principal regulations there shall be added the following regulation :—

"Effect of regulations for the purposes of section 23 of the Act

6. The provisions of these regulations shall not have effect for the purpose of the determination of any question whether a person is or is not engaged in a gainful occupation which arises under section 23 of the Act (which section relates to increase of benefit for adult dependants) or any regulations made thereunder."

Amendment relating to employment of a casual nature for the purposes of the employer's trade or business

3.—(1) Part II of the First Schedule to the principal regulations (which Part sets out, in column (A), employments in respect of which persons are treated as self-employed persons and, in column (B), the persons excepted from the operation of column (A)) shall be amended in accordance with the succeeding paragraph of this regulation.

(2) Immediately after the word "business" in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 6 of column (B) (which sub-paragraph relates to persons in employment of a casual nature which is for the purposes of the employer's trade or business) there shall be added the following words :—

"or, where the employer is a public or local authority, for the purposes of the exercise and performance of the powers and duties of the authority".

Amendment relating to employment in connection with Parliamentary and other elections

4. In Part III of the First Schedule to the principal regulations (which Part sets out in column (A) employments in respect of which persons are treated as non-employed persons and their employment therein disregarded and in column (B), the persons excepted from the operation of column (A)) and immediately after paragraph 57, there shall be added —

(a) in column (A) the following paragraph :—

“ 58. Employment in connection with the recording or counting of votes for the purposes of —

(a) a Parliamentary or local government election ; or

(b) an election held for the purposes of a society, association or similar body ” ; and

(b) in column (B) the following paragraph :—

“ 58. None.”
