

- (b) by carelessness or neglect suffers any loss, damage or injury to occur to any person or property ; or
 - (c) without permission or sufficient cause leaves his station or place of duty ; or
 - (d) fails to report any matter which it is his duty to report ; or
 - (e) fails to make an entry, which it is his duty to make, in any book or document ;
- (5) Falsehood, that is to say, if he—
- (a) knowingly makes any false or misleading statement, whether in writing or not, in the course of his functions as a member of the fire brigade ; or
 - (b) without sufficient cause, destroys or mutilates any official book or document, or alters or erases any entry therein ;
- (6) Breach of confidence, that is to say, if he divulges any matter which it is his duty to keep secret ;
- (7) Corrupt practice, that is to say, if he—
- (a) improperly uses his position as a member of the fire brigade for his private advantage ; or
 - (b) fails to account for, or to make a prompt and true return of, any money or property which comes into his possession in the course of his duties ;
- (8) Absence from duty, that is to say, if he, without reasonable excuse, is absent from duty or is late for any parade, drill or other attendance ;
- (9) Damage to clothing or personal equipment, that is to say, if he—
- (a) wilfully or negligently damages any article of clothing or personal equipment with which he had been provided or entrusted or fails to take proper care thereof ; or
 - (b) fails to report any damage to or loss of any article of clothing or personal equipment, however caused ;
- (10) Drunkenness, that is to say, if, when on duty or liable to be called upon for duty, he is unfit for duty through drink ; or
- (11) Discreditable or disorderly conduct, that is to say, if he—
- (a) acts in a disorderly manner or in any manner prejudicial to discipline ; or
 - (b) while on duty or while off duty in uniform in a public place, is without reasonable excuse dirty or untidy in his person, clothing or personal equipment ; or
 - (c) acts in a manner likely to bring discredit on the reputation of the fire brigade.

Financial Provisions

REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST APRIL, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION THREE OF THE FIRE SERVICES (AMENDMENT) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

1950. No. 53

The Ministry of Home Affairs, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section three of the Fire Services (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fire Services (Finance) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

(3) In these Regulations —

“ the Act ” means the Fire Services (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1950 ;

“ the Authority ” means the Northern Ireland Fire Authority ;

“ the Ministry ” means the Ministry of Home Affairs.

2. The estimate to be furnished by the Authority to the Ministry in pursuance of section three of the Act shall be in the form set forth in the Schedule to these Regulations and shall be furnished to the Ministry on or before the 1st day of December immediately preceding the financial year to which the estimate relates :

Provided that the estimate for the financial year ending 31st March, 1951, may be in such form as the Ministry may direct and may be submitted at such later date as the Ministry may allow.

3. The Fire Services (Finance) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1948 (a) are hereby revoked.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the date hereof.
