

4. Regulation 44 of and Part I (e) (ii) of the First Schedule to the principal Regulations shall be amended by the deletion of the date " 1st April, 1951 " and the substitution therefor of the date " 1st April, 1955 ".

5. Regulation 57 of the principal Regulations shall be amended by the deletion of the second paragraph of that Regulation and the substitution of the following paragraph therefor :—

" The period of such absence shall rank for increment except that when the course is such that its successful completion would qualify the teacher for admission to a higher salary scale, any absence in respect of which salary is not paid, shall not, save in exceptional circumstances, rank for increment."

Scientific Research Grants

REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST MAY, 1950, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER SECTIONS 77 AND 104 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1947, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1950. No. 74

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as " the Ministry "), in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 77 and 104 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1947, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Scientific Research Grants Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1950.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the date thereof.

2. After consultation with an Advisory Board composed of such suitably qualified persons as the Ministry may from time to time

appoint thereto, the Ministry may make grants (hereinafter referred to as "scientific research grants") to scientific research workers and research students of approved qualifications.

3. Scientific research grants may be either :—

- (a) Maintenance Allowances to assist students to undergo training in scientific research or
- (b) Senior Research Awards to enable investigators of exceptional promise to devote their whole time to original scientific research.

4. Scientific research grants shall be of such amount and be subject to such conditions as may be determined from time to time by the Ministry with the consent of the Ministry of Finance.

5. The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
