FLAX

REGULATIONS DATED 11TH OCTOBER, 1951, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTIONS ELEVEN AND EIGHTEEN OF THE FLAX ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1949.

1951: No 186

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections eleven and eighteen of the Flax Act (Northern Ireland), 1949, and of all other powers it enabling, the Ministry of Agriculture hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Flax (General) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951.

(2) These Regulations shall come into force on 15th October, 1951.

2. In paragraph (4) of Regulation 8 of the Flax (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1949, (which prescribes maximum charges for the scutching of flax and tow) for sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c), there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraphs :—

- (a) In respect of flax scutched wholly or mainly by hand, an amount calculated at the rate of 8s. 3d. per stone produced ;
- (b) In respect of flax scutched wholly or mainly by turbine scutching machine, an amount calculated at the rate of 9s. per stone produced ;
- (c) In respect of re-scutched tow, an amount calculated at the rate of 4s. 6d. per stone produced.
