REGULATIONS, DATED 15TH AUGUST, 1952, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE HOUSING ON FARMS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1950.

1952. No. 156

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section fifteen of the Housing on Farms Act (Northern Ireland), 1950, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Housing on Farms (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1952.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Housing on Farms Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1951 (a) shall have effect as if for the words "6 feet" in paragraph (2) of the Third Schedule thereto and the words "six feet" in paragraph (2) of the Sixth Schedule thereto, there were substituted the words "five feet".
