## THE UTILITY FURNITURE (MARKING AND SUPPLY) (REVOCATION) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1952.

## 1952. No. 221

In exercise of the powers under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, as having effect by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945 (a), (as extended by the Supplies and Services (Extended Purposes) Act, 1947 (b), and the Supplies and Services (Defence Purposes) Act, 1951 (c), and continued in force by the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1951 (d) ) delegated to it by an Instrument of Delegation dated the 2nd day of July, 1946, made by the Board of Trade under the said Regulations, as having effect as aforesaid, and of all other powers it enabling, the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland hereby orders as follows :---

1. The Utility Furniture (Marking and Supply) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1952 (e), is hereby revoked.

2. This Order may be cited as the Utility Furniture (Marking and Supply) (Revocation) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1952, and shall come into operation on the 15th day of December, 1952.
