Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations, 1952

REGULATIONS DATED 9TH APRIL, 1952, MADE BY THE FOYLE FISHERIES COMMISSION WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE OF THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND AND THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT, 1952, AND SECTION 13 OF THE FOYLE FISHERIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1952.

The Foyle Fisheries Commission hereinafter referred to as "the Commission" in exercise of its powers under Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act, 1952 and Section 13 of the Foyle Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland), 1952 hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Foyle Area (Licensing of Fishing Engines) Regulations, 1952.

2. In these regulations "the Foyle tideway" means the tidal portions of the River Foyle and of its tributary the River Faughan.

3. A person shall not fish for salmon with rod and line in any part of the Foyle Area unless he is the holder of a salmon rod licence for the time being in force and issued by the Commission in pursuance of these regulations.

4.—(1) A salmon rod licence available for the period specified therein may be issued by the Commission on payment by the applicant of a licence fee of two pounds provided that if the applicant produces at the time of application a salmon rod licence for the time being in force and issued by a Board of Conservators in respect of which a licence fee of not less than thirty shillings has been paid the licence fee payable under this article shall be ten shillings.

(2) A salmon rod licence available for seven days only from the date of issue may be issued on payment by the applicant of a licence fee of ten shillings.

5. A person shall not use in any part of the Foyle Area for the capture of salmon or trout any fishing engine, other than rod and line, in respect of which there is not for the time being in force a licence issued by the Commission in pursuance of these regulations authorising the use of that engine in that part of the Foyle Area.

6. A licence authorising the use of any fishing engine specified in the first column of the schedule hereto may (subject to any regulations for the time being in force limiting the issuable number of licences of that particular kind) be issued upon payment to the Commission in the manner hereinafter prescribed of the fee specified in the second column of the said schedule opposite the mention of such fishing engine.

7. The licence fee in respect of any fishing engine other than rod and line shall be paid in the following manner :—

(a) where the application is made for a licence for a bag net, a stake net, or for a draft net or drift net to be used in any part of the Foyle Area other than the Foyle tideway the licence fee shall be paid in full at the time of application ;

(b) where the application is made for a licence for a draft net to be used in any part of the Foyle tideway

(i) if the application is made on or before the 5th day of June in any year one moiety of the licence fee shall be paid on application subject to the condition (which shall be endorsed on the licence) that the second moiety shall be paid on or before the 15th day of June in such year ;

- (ii) if the application is made after the 5th day of June in any year the whole amount of the licence fee shall be paid on application.

8. Where a licence is issued subject to a condition as to deferred payment of portion of the licence fee, than if there is a breach of such condition such licence shall cease to be in force immediately upon such breach.

9. The River Foyle (Special Local Licences) Order, 1949, (S.I. No. 104 of 1949) and the River Foyle (Special Local Licence Duty) (Method of Payment) Order, 1951, (S.I. No. 47 of 1951) are hereby revoked.
