ORDER DATED 12TH APRIL, 1957, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION TWENTY-NINE OF THE COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1955.

I, The Right Honourable W. W. B. Topping, Q.C., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section twenty-nine of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland), 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do hereby order as follows:—

1. All the remaining provisions of the Act not already in operation shall come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1957.

2. This Order may be cited as the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland), 1955, (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland), 1957.

County Court Costs Rules (Northern Ireland), 1957

Whereas the fees, costs and charges lawfully payable to counsel and solicitors in the county courts were increased generally by a direction duly given the 1st day of July, 1920,

And whereas the jurisdiction of the county courts in Northern Ireland was in certain respects extended by the County Court Jurisdiction Act (Northern Ireland), 1942, and certain of the scales of fees, costs and charges then in force were accordingly amended by a direction duly given by the Lord Chief Justice the 11th day of May, 1943,

And whereas by a like direction duly given the 29th day of February, 1944, the amounts prescribed by the scales of fees, costs and charges then in force were increased generally
