Notwithstanding anything contained in section twenty-four of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the said Petty Sessions shall, for the purposes of any appeal against a decision of the said Court, be deemed to have been held in the Petty Sessions District of Gortin.

3. This Order may be cited as the Petty Sessions Districts and Times (Gortin) Order (Northern Ireland), 1958.

WAKEHURST

Whereas by paragraph (e) of sub-section (1) of section five of the Superannuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1951(a), the Governor of Northern Ireland is empowered to designate by Order in Council a class of employment as pensionable employment for the purposes of that paragraph where the Ministry of Finance is satisfied that the employment entitles a person therein employed to superannuation benefits substantially similar to those conferred by or under the Superannuation Acts.
