Holden, Assistant Secretary. **Housing Subsidy Order** ORDER* DATED 21ST APRIL, 1958, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER SECTION ONE OF THE HOUSING (No. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946. 1958. No. 74 The Ministry of Health and Local Government (in this Order referred to as " the Ministry "), with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section one of the Housing (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1958, and shall be construed as one with the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1956(a) (in this Order referred to as "the principal Order") and the Housing Subsidy Order (Northern Ireland), 1957(b). . .

2. In the principal Order the following Article shall be added after Article 4A:-

"4B. Where a new house of any area specified in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order has been provided by a local authority in pursuance of a contract or part of a contract---(a) which has been designated by the Ministry for the

purposes of this Article; and (b) in respect of which the tender has been submitted for approval to the Ministry on or after the 15th day

of March, 1958, and before the 1st day of January, Hotsey & or M 1959; St. M. M. T. 155

then the Ministry shall pay to the local authority in respect of that house sixty successive annual contributions of three pounds fifteen shillings in addition to the contributions payable under Articles 4 and 4A and the local authority shall in respect of each such contribution of three pounds fifteen shillings pay to the credit of their Housing Revenue Account an amount equivalent to one-third thereof."

3. In Article 9(3) of the principal Order after the number "4" there shall be inserted the numbers "4A, 4B".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The object of this Order is to provide for the payment of an additional contribution of £3 15s. 0d. from the Exchequer and £1 5s. 0d. from the Rates; each year for sixty years, in respect of local authority houses for which tenders have been submitted for approval to the Ministry on or after 15th March, 1958, and before 1st January, 1959.

The annual sum of £3 15s. 0d. from the Exchequer will also be payable in the case of houses to be built by housing associations.

The full amount of £5 a house, each year, will be payable from the Exchequer in the case of houses to be built by the Northern Ireland Housing Trust.

The Order further provides that in the case of the Housing Trust and housing associations the governing date is, in accordance with practice, the date of acceptance of a tender rather than the date of submission to the Ministry.
