NATIONAL INSURANCE

Commencement Order (Northern Ireland), 1959

Order, dated 21st July, 1959, made by the Minister of Labour and National Insurance under the Family Allowances and National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959.

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (4) of section 5 of the Family Allowances and National Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1959(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") that the provisions of that section (which amends certain enactments relating to increases in retirement pensions for contributions paid in respect of the period after pensionable age) shall not affect any of the enactments therein referred to as respects contributions paid for contribution weeks commencing before such day as the Minister of Labour and National Insurance may by order appoint:

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Ivan Neill, Minister of Labour and National Insurance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 5 of the Act and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

1. The day appointed for the purposes of the said sub-section (4) of section 5 shall be the 3rd August, 1959.

2. This Order may be cited as the National Insurance (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland), 1959.
