- (c) the diversion of sewers or drains and transmission, distribution or service mains;
- (d) street lighting in new roads or the improvement of street lighting in existing roads;
- (e) such other works as may be approved by the Ministry.
- 5. Works of improvement and maintenance means :---
- (a) works of improvement;
- (b) works of repair;
- (c) management including printing and stationery and rent collection;
- (d) such other works as may be approved by the Ministry.

These Regulations prescribe the items which may be included as preliminary re-development works for the purpose of section 13 of the Housing (Miscellaneous Provisions) and Rent Restriction Law (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1956.

## AID TO INDUSTRY (AMENDMENT) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1959

I, The Right Honourable Lord Glentoran, H.M.L., Minister of Commerce for Northern Ireland, with the approval of the Right Honourable Terence M. O'Neill, D.L., Minister of Finance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Aid to Industry Act (Northern Ireland), 1953, hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Industry (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland), 1959, and shall come into operation on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.

2. The Aid to Industry Order (Northern Ireland), 1957(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order") shall have effect subject to the modifications specified in this Order.
