DISEASES OF ANIMALS

Foot and Mouth Disease (Importation) Order, 1960

Order, dated 14th November, 1960, made by the Ministry of Agriculture under section 18 of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland), 1958(b).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section eighteen of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland), 1958, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement.

1. This Order which may be cited as the Foot and Mouth Disease (Importation) Order (Northern Ireland), 1960, shall come into operation on the 14th November, 1960.

Restriction on Importation of Dogs and Cats

2. A person shall not bring or cause to be brought into Northern Ireland from Great Britain, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man, any dog or other member of the family canidae, or any cat or other member of the family felidae except under and in accordance with the conditions of a licence issued by the Ministry, or by an Officer duly authorised by the Ministry.
