- (a) For so much of the Register as relates to Boroughs and Urban Districts at the rate of 52/per 100 Electors
- (b) For so much of the Register as relates to rural areas and areas not included under (a) above at the rate of 63/per 100 Electors

6. In the County Borough of Belfast, the allowance for expenses, other than out-of-pocket expenses set out in paragraph 7, of the electoral officer, shall not exceed 33/- per 100 electors.

7. Every electoral officer shall be allowed as and for out-of-pocket expenses the actual and necessary cost of any:—

Stationery and Miscellaneous Local Printing.

Postages.

Charge by H.M. Stationery Office for centrally-printed forms.

Charge by H.M. Stationery Office for printing Lists and Register.

Miscellaneous out-of-pocket expenses not elsewhere specified.

HOUSING ON FARMS

Grants in respect of farmhouses and of approved workers' houses

Order*, dated 29th November, 1961, made by the Ministry of Health and Local Government, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, under section 12 of the Housing on Farms Act (Northern Ireland), 1950.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry"), with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Ministry by section 12 of the Housing on Farms Act (Northern Ireland), 1950(a) (in this Order referred to as "the Act"), and of every other power it thereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Housing on Farms (Grants) Order (Northern Ireland), 1961, and shall, subject to the provisions of sub-section (4) of section 12 of the Act, come into operation on the 29th day of November, 1961.

Grants for provision of new farmhouses

2. The amount of grant payable under section 1 of the Act in respect of a new farmhouse completed before the 1st day of January, 1964, in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry before the

Ist day of January, 1963, and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for provision of houses for approved workers

3. The amount of grant payable under section 4 of the Act in respect of an approved worker's house completed before the 1st day of January, 1964, in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry before the 1st day of January, 1963, and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.

Grants for reconditioning premises as farmhouses or approved workers' houses

4. The amount of grant payable under section 7 of the Act in respect of the reconditioning of any premises for use as a farmhouse or approved worker's house completed before the 1st day of January, 1964, in accordance with plans submitted to and approved by the Ministry on or after the 4th day of February, 1955, and before the 1st day of January, 1963, and falling within any one of the categories mentioned in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order shall be the amount specified opposite such category in the second column of the said Schedule.
