

- (h) do not apply to any emulsifier or stabiliser, or any food containing any emulsifier or stabiliser, intended for export (Regulation 2(3));
- (i) provide that the Public Health (Preservatives, etc., in Food) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1927 to 1958, shall not apply to any emulsifier or stabiliser or as respects any emulsifier or stabiliser in food and revoke the provisions of those regulations relating to thickening substances for cream (Regulations 2(4) and 10);
- (j) do not apply to milk: with regard to this, separate Milk (Emulsifiers and Stabilisers) Regulations have been made.

The regulations will come into operation on the 16th July, 1962, save that the provisions relating to the labelling and advertisement of permitted emulsifiers and stabilisers (Regulations 5(2) and 6) will come into operation on 14th January, 1963.

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH APRIL, 1962, MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE PHARMACEUTICAL SOCIETY OF NORTHERN IRELAND WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS, UNDER SECTION THREE OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1925.

The Council of the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section Three of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act (Northern Ireland), 1925(a), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland (General) (Amending) Regulations, 1962, and shall come into operation on the 1st June, 1962.

Amendment of Regulation 6 of Regulations of 1959

2. For regulation 6 of the Pharmaceutical Society of Northern Ireland (General) (No. 2) Regulations, 1959(b), there shall be substituted the following regulation:

“6. The Retention Fee under section eight of the Act of 1945 payable annually by a Member of the Society resident in Northern Ireland in respect of the retention of his name on the Register shall be four pounds; by a Member of the Society resident outside Northern Ireland two guineas; by an Associate of the Society one guinea and by a Student of the Society five shillings. The Retention Fee shall be due and payable on the first day of September of each year. Provided that any member who became a Life Member prior to the 24th May, 1945, shall not be required to pay a Retention Fee.”
