ULSTER SAVINGS CERTIFICATES

Tenth Issue

REGULATIONS, DATED 15TH APRIL, 1964, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 15(1) OF THE EXCHEQUER AND FINANCIAL PROVISIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1950.

The Ministry of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 15(1) of the Exchequer and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland) 1950(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Ulster Savings Certificates (Tenth Issue) (Amendment) Regulations 1964.

(2) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962(b) and 1963(c), and those Regulations and these Regulations may be cited together as the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962 to 1964.

2. Schedule 3 to the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations 1962 (which Schedule prescribes the maximum number of certificates which may be held), as amended by the Ulster Savings Certificates (Tenth Issue) Regulations 1963, shall be further amended by substituting for the words “Three hundred” in paragraph (f) of the said Schedule the words “Six hundred”.

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 21st day of April, 1964.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations amend the Ulster Savings Certificates (Tenth Issue) Regulations 1963. Their effect is to increase the maximum permitted holding of Ulster Savings Certificates of the Tenth Issue from 300 unit Certificates (£300) to 600 unit Certificates (£600) as from 21st April, 1964.
