LEGAL AID AND ADVICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965**Date of Commencement**

ORDER, DATED 26TH APRIL, 1965, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 34(2) OF THE LEGAL AID AND ADVICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

I, the Right Honourable Robert William Brian McConnell, Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 34(2) of the Legal Aid and Advice Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") do hereby order as follows:—

1. The provisions of the Act specified in the first column of the Schedule, which relate to matters specified in the second column of the Schedule, shall come into operation on the first day of May, 1965.

2. This Order may be cited as the Legal Aid and Advice Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1965.

<i>Provisions of the Act</i>	<i>Subject Matter</i>
Part I, Sections 10, 11, 12, 13 and 15	Functions of the Incorporated Law Society of Northern Ireland under Part I of the Act, the establishment and administration of the Legal Aid Fund, accounts and audit of the Legal Aid Fund, pension rights of persons employed by the said Law Society for the purposes of the said Part I and the power of the Minister of Home Affairs to appoint an advisory committee to advise him on certain questions relating to the said Part I.
