MARKETING OF POULTRY

REGULATIONS, DATED THE 26TH DAY OF JULY 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE MARKETING OF POULTRY ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1949(a).

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Marketing of Poultry Act (Northern Ireland) 1949, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Short Title and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Marketing of Poultry (Amendment No. 3) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966.

Revocation

2. Regulation 17 of the Marketing of Poultry (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965(b) (which was directed to come into force on the 1st day of August 1966) is hereby revoked and shall not come into force.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations revoke Regulation 17 of the Marketing of Poultry (Amendment No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1965, which required that as from 1st August 1966 only poultry which have been killed on a packer's own premises shall be eviscerated there.
