REGULATIONS, DATED 2ND AUGUST 1966, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT UNDER SECTION 18 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1934.

The Ministry of Development (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in exercise of the powers vested in it by section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1934(b), and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Belfast County Borough Council (Planning Officers' Qualifications) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966.
