# TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

### The Redundancy Fund (Advances out of the Consolidated Fund) Order (Northern Ireland) 1968

ORDER\*, DATED 16TH FEBRUARY 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 45(2) OF THE CONTRACTS OF EMPLOYMENT AND REDUNDANCY PAYMENTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services with the consent of the Ministry of Finance in exercise of powers conferred by section 45(2) of the Contracts of Employment and Redundancy Payments Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:-

### Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Redundancy Fund (Advances out of the Consolidated Fund) Order (Northern Ireland) 1968.

#### Advances out of the Consolidated Fund

2. The aggregate amount outstanding at any time during the period of one year beginning with the date of this Order by way of principal in respect of sums advanced under the said section 45 out of the Consolidated Fund for the purposes of the Northern Ireland Redundancy Fund shall not exceed four hundred thousand pounds.
