ROAD TRAFFIC: BOX JUNCTIONS

REGULATIONS, DATED 19TH DECEMBER 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1929(a).

Commencement and Citation

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st January 1969, and may be cited as the Road Traffic (Box Junctions) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations "Principal Regulations" means the Road Traffic (Box Junctions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967(b).

General

3. The Principal Regulations shall have effect as if in Regulation 2 after the words "...... the intersection of two or more roads" there were inserted the words "or of a road with a railway".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations extend the legal requirements conveyed by the road traffic device known as a "Box Junction" to the intersection of a road and a railway. It is intended to use such markings at level crossings, particularly those controlled by automatic half-barrier equipment.
