SUPPLEMENTARY BENEFITS

Requirements

REGULATIONS, DATED 28TH FEBRUARY 1968, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, UNDER THE SUPPLEMENTARY BENEFITS &c. ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Ministry of Health and Social Services, with the consent of the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of powers conferred by section 5(1) of the Supplementary Benefits &c. Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Supplementary Benefit (Requirements) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1968, and shall come into operation on 1st March 1968.

Requirements in respect of dental services

2. The requirements to be taken into account for the purposes of the Supplementary Benefits &c. Act (Northern Ireland) 1966 shall include any requirement for dental services, not being services provided under the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948(b), which, if they were so provided, would be services in respect of which charges are for the time being authorised by regulations made under section 76 of that Act.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations extend the requirements taken into account for the purposes of the Supplementary Benefits &c. Act (Northern Ireland) 1966 to include any requirement for dental services which if they were provided under the Health Services Act (Northern Ireland) 1948 would be subject to charges.
