GOODS VEHICLES: CERTIFICATION

REGULATIONS, DATED 13TH MAY 1969, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER SECTION 25 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1934, SECTION 21 OF THE FINANCE (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1955 AND SECTION 72 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1955.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 25 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1934(a), Section 21 of the Finance (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1955(b), Section 72 of the Road Traffic Act (Northern Ireland) 1955(c) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Goods Vehicles (Certification) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1969 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1969.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations the expression "the Principal Regulations" means the Goods Vehicles (Certification) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966(d).

Amendment to Principal Regulations

3. For Regulation 8 of the Principal Regulations there shall be substituted the following Regulation:—

"Fees

8. The prescribed fees shall be as follows: ---

- (2) For a goods vehicle not coming within the provisions of paragraph (1):—

 - (c) Where the vehicle exceeds in weight 2 tons unladen ... 90s."

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations increase the amount of fees payable for goods vehicles certificates. The fees set out in Regulation 3 have been increased from 20s., 30s., 40s. and 70s. respectively.
