Order*, dated 6th February 1969, made by the Minister of Health and Social Services, with the approval of the Minister of Finance, under section 15(c) of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.

I, the Right Honourable Robert Wilson Porter, Q.C., Minister of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 15(c) of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Clean Air Act (Grant Extension) Order (Northern Ireland) 1969.
- 2. The provisions of section 12 (which provides for the making by local authorities of payments towards the expenditure incurred on adaptations in or in connection with certain private dwellings) and section 13 (which provides for contributions by the Ministry towards the expenses incurred by local authorities in making payments in respect of adaptations or in carrying out adaptations required by notice) of the Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 shall extend to any private dwelling:—
 - (a) erected,
 - (b) produced by conversion (with or without the addition of premises erected before the 1st day of March 1969), or
- (c) the erection or conversion of which was begun, prior to the 1st day of March 1969, other than private dwellings owned or under the control of a local authority or the Northern Ireland Housing Trust.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The Clean Air Act (Northern Ireland) 1964 provides for grants to the owners or occupiers of private dwellings who have to incur expenditure on adaptations to their heating and cooking arrangements to comply with a Smoke Control Order. Private dwellings erected or converted after the passing of the Act (9th June 1964) were excluded from these grant arrangements. This Order extends the grant arrangements to private dwellings (other than those owned or under the control of a local authority or the Northern Ireland Housing Trust) erected or converted prior to the coming into force of the new arrangements.
