- I, the Right Honourable William Kennedy Fitzsimmons, Minister of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 2(3) of the Health Service Contributions Act (Northern Ireland) 1970(a) do hereby order as follows:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Health Service Contributions Act (Appointed Day) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970.
- 2. The Health Service Contributions Act (Northern Ireland) 1970 shall come into force on 6th July 1970.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

This Order brings into force from 6th July 1970 the Health Service Contributions Act (Northern Ireland) 1970, which provides for the increase of the health service contributions payable by employers from 8d. a week to 1s. 8d. a week.
