**TRANSFERRED EXCISE DUTIES:****General Betting Duty (Amendment) Regulations**

REGULATIONS, DATED 29TH OCTOBER 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER PARTS I AND III OF SCHEDULE 2 TO THE FINANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1966.

The Ministry of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Parts I and III of Schedule 2 to the Finance Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the General Betting Duty (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970, and shall come into operation on 16th November 1970.

(2) These regulations, the General Betting Duty Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966(b) and the General Betting Duty (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1967(c) shall be construed as one and may be cited together as the General Betting Duty Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 to 1970.

(3) In these Regulations the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

“the principal Regulations” means the General Betting Duty Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966.

“Regulation” means a Regulation contained in the principal Regulations.

2. In Regulation 22(2)(c) of the principal Regulations after the words “shall be produced” there shall be inserted the words “or delivered”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)*

These Regulations amend the General Betting Duty Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1966 and 1967 by providing that an off-course bookmaker shall, on demand, deliver to an authorised officer all documents recording bets.
