ROAD FREIGHT TRANSPORT LICENSING (FEES)

REGULATIONS*, DATED 21ST DECEMBER 1970, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE TRANSPORT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1967.

The Ministry of Development with the approval of the Ministry of Finance in exercise of the powers vested in it by Sections 23(2) and 25(2) and 25(4) of the Transport Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Freight Transport Licensing (Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970 and shall come into operation on 15th February 1971.

Alterations of road freight vehicle licence fees

2. The amounts of the fees payable under Sections 23(1), 25(2) and 25(4) of the Act shall be £10.50 and £1.50 instead of the amounts of £10 and £1 respectively wherever such amounts are mentioned in the said sections.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations prescribe alterations in the amounts of the fees payable for the grant of road freight vehicle licences under the Transport Act (Northern Ireland) 1967. They provide for increases of 50 new pence in the fee for an annual licence and 50 new pence per month for a short-term licence for up to three months.
