#### **MAGISTRATES' COURTS**

### Children and Young Persons (Amendment) Rules

Rules, dated 24th June 1971, made by the Minister of Home Affairs under section 23 of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964.

I, the Right Honourable Brian Faulkner, D.L., Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 23 of the Magistrates' Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1964(a) and all other powers thereunto enabling, do hereby upon the recommendation of the Magistrates' Courts Rules Committee and after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, make the Rules hereinafter set forth.
