SUPPLEMENTARY BENEFITS**Commencement Order (Northern Ireland) 1971**

ORDER, DATED 29TH OCTOBER 1971, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES UNDER THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1971.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 9(3) of the Social Security Act (Northern Ireland) 1971(a) that the provisions of that Act except sections 3 to 6 and 9(1) to (5) shall come into force on such day or days as the Minister may by order appoint:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE WILLIAM KENNEDY FITZSIMMONS, Minister of Health and Social Services, hereby make the following order:

1. The day appointed for the coming into force of section 1(2) and (5) (and section 1(1) so far as it relates to section 1(2)) of the Social Security Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 (amendment of supplementary benefit provisions for calculating requirements) shall be 5th November 1971.

2. The day appointed for the coming into force of section 1(3) and (4) (and section 1(1) so far as it relates to section 1(3) and (4)) of that Act (amendment of supplementary benefit provisions for calculating resources) shall be 3rd November 1971.

3. The day appointed for the coming into force of section 2 of the said Act (supplementary benefit following return to work after a trade dispute to be recoverable by deductions from earnings) shall be 3rd April 1972.

4. This order may be cited as the Supplementary Benefits (Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1971.
