Training Scholarships

REGULATIONS, DATED 6TH DECEMBER 1971, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1947 TO 1968, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 59 and 77 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland) 1947(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Training of Teachers (Scholarships) Amending Regulations (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) 1971.

2. The existing Regulations hereby amended are the Training of Teachers (Scholarships) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1970(b).

3. For sub-paragraph 2(4)(b) of the First Schedule to the existing Regulations there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraphs:—

“(b) (i) disability pensions not liable to income tax;

(ii) for the academic year 1971/72 and subsequent academic years any income received in respect of service as a Reservist with the Armed Forces or in the Ulster Defence Regiment or in the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations enable the Ministry to ignore when calculating the value of scholarships for the 1971/72 and subsequent academic years any income received by a student for service as a Reservist with the Armed Forces or in the Ulster Defence Regiment or in the Royal Ulster Constabulary Reserve.
