# Reduction of Rates on Dwelling-houses

REGULATIONS\*, DATED 23RD DECEMBER 1971, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF DEVELOPMENT UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (FINANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1967.

The Ministry of Development in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 1 of the Local Government (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) hereby makes the following regulations:—

#### Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Reduction of Rates on Dwellinghouses (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1971.

## Reduction of domestic rates

2. The amount in the pound by which the rates levied by rating authorities on dwelling-houses are to be reduced for the financial year commencing 1st April 1972 shall be thirty new pence.
