

**COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959****County Courts—Belfast Recorder's Court—Additional Sittings**

ORDER, DATED 29TH JUNE 1972, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 5(3) OF THE COUNTY COURTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1959.

I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE WILLIAM WHITELAW, M.C., M.P., one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 5(3) of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959(a), Article 3 of the County Courts (Additional Sittings) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972(b) and section 1(1)(a) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(c), do hereby order as follows:—

*Citation*

1. This Order may be cited as the County Courts (Additional Sitting) (Belfast Recorder's Court) Order (Northern Ireland) 1972.

*Time of Sitting*

2. An Additional Sitting of the Belfast Recorder's Court shall be held in the months of August and September 1972 and shall commence on the 7th day of August 1972.

*Business to be transacted*

3. The business to be transacted at the Additional Sitting shall be all such proceedings as are specified in section 5(3) of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order fixes an Additional Sitting of the Belfast Recorder's Court for the hearing of proceedings to which Part V or Part VI of the County Courts Act (Northern Ireland) 1959 applies. These Parts relate respectively to the original criminal jurisdiction of the county courts by way of trial on indictment and to appeals to those courts against orders of courts of summary jurisdiction.
