Extension of Definition of Poultry

ORDER, DATED 1ST JUNE 1973, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1958.

The Ministry of Agriculture, on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(2) of the Diseases of Animals Act (Northern Ireland) 1958(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: --

Citation and commencement

1. This Order which may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Amendment of First Schedule—Poultry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973 shall come into operation on 18th June 1973.

Revocation

2. The Quail Order (Northern Ireland) 1967(b) and the Diseases of Animals (Amendment of First Schedule—Poultry) Order (Northern Ireland) 1970(c) are hereby revoked.

Amendment of Part II of the First Schedule

- 3. Part II of the First Schedule of the Act shall be amended as follows:—
- (a) for the words "Birds of the following kinds, that is to say:—" there shall be substituted the words "Birds belonging to the following orders: -":
- (b) items 1 to 14 shall be deleted therefrom and the following items added for the purposes of the Act—
 - 1. Anseriformes (including swans, geese and ducks).
 - 2. Apodiformes (including swifts and humming birds).
 - 3. Apterygiformes (kiwis).
 - 4. Caprimulgiformes (including nightiars).
 - 5. Casuariiformes (including emus and cassowaries).
 - 6. Charadriiformes (including waders, gulls and snipes).
 - 7. Ciconiiformes (including storks and flamingoes).
 - 8. Coliiformes (mousebirds).

 - 9. Columbiformes (including pigeons and doves).
 10. Coraciiformes (including kingfishers and hornbills).
 11. Cuculiformes (including cuckoos).

 - 12. Falconiformes (including hawks and eagles).
 - 13. Galliformes (including fowls, turkeys, pheasants, partridges and quails).

 14. Gaviiformes (divers).

 - 15. Gruiformes (including cranes).
 - 16. Passeriformes (including sparrows, finches and myna birds).
 - 17. Pelecaniformes (including pelicans).

- 19. Podicipitiformes (grebes).20. Procellariiformes (including petrels and albatrosses).

- 23. Strigiformes (owls).
- 24. Struthioniformes (ostriches).
