ORDER, DATED 24TH SEPTEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER ARTICLE 1 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1973.

In exercise of the power conferred upon me by Article 1 of the Road Traffic (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973(a) and section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(b) I hereby order as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Order 1973 (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973.
- 2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 3. The provisions of the Order specified in the first column of the Schedule which relates to matters specified in the second column of the said Schedule shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 1973. 4223
