REDUCTION OF RATES ON DWELLING-HOUSES

Local Government (Reduction of Rates on Dwelling-houses) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973

Coming into operation . . . 16th March 1973

To be laid before the Parliament of the United Kingdom under paragraph 4(5)(b) of the Schedule to the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972.

The Ministry of Development on behalf of the Secretary of State and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1 of the Local Government (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland) 1967(a) and Article 4 and Schedule 3 of the Local Government (Postponement of Elections and Reorganisation) (Northern Ireland) Order 1972(b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Reduction of Rates on Dwelling-houses) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1973 and shall come into operation on 16th March 1973.

Reduction of domestic rates

2. The amount in the pound by which the rates levied by rating authorities on dwelling-houses are to be reduced for the period of six months ending on the 30th September 1973 shall be seventeen pence.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations prescribe the reduction in the pound in rates to be levied by rating authorities on dwelling-houses for the period of six months ending on the 30th September 1973.
