Proceedings under the Fair Trading Act 1973

ORDER, DATED 11TH DECEMBER 1973, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 34(2) OF THE LEGAL AID AND ADVICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1965.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 34(2) of the Legal Aid and Advice Act (Northern Ireland) 1965(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(b) I hereby order as follows:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Legal Aid and Advice Act (Northern Ireland) 1965 (Date of Commencement) No. 8 Order 1973.

Commencement of Part I of Act in relation to proceedings in Restrictive Practices Court under Fair Trading Act 1973

2. The provisions of Part I of the Act shall come into operation on 1st February 1974 for the purpose of making legal aid available in connection with proceedings in the Restrictive Practices Court under Part III of the Fair Trading Act 1973(c), and any proceedings in that Court in consequence of an order made, or undertaking given to the Court, under that Part of that Act.
