## VEHICLES EXCISE

## Vehicles (Excise) Act (Northern Ireland) 1972

## Date of Commencement

ORDER, DATED 24th MARCH 1973, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 38(2) OF THE VEHICLES (EXCISE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1972.

In exercise of the power conferred upon me by section 38(2) of the Vehicles (Excise) Act (Northern Ireland) 1972(a) and section 1(1) of the Northern Ireland (Temporary Provisions) Act 1972(b) I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Vehicles (Excise) Act (Northern Ireland) 1972 (Date of Commencement) Order (Northern Ireland) 1973.

2. The following provisions of the Vehicles (Excise) Act (Northern Ireland) 1972 shall come into operation on 1st April 1973, that is to say—

(a) paragraph (h) of subsection (1) of section 23 and so much of that section as relates thereto;

(b) section 34.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)*

This Order brings into operation the following provisions of the Vehicles (Excise) Act (Northern Ireland) 1972 :—

Section 23(1)(h) and (3), which enables the registration of a vehicle to be refused unless satisfactory evidence of the payment of car tax in respect of the vehicle is produced.

Section 34, which gives the power to make regulations.
