## The Management of Offenders etc. (Scotland) Act 2005 (Members' Remuneration and Supplementary Provisions) Order 2008

## Members' remuneration, allowances and expenses

- **3.** For article 10(1) of the Community Justice Authorities (Establishment, Constitution and Proceedings) (Scotland) Order 2006(1) substitute—
  - "(1) The provisions of regulations 4 and 5 of, and Schedule 2 to, the Local Government (Allowances and Expenses) (Scotland) Regulations 2007(2) shall apply in respect of the allowances and expenses payable to members of an authority by the authority as if—
    - (a) such members are members of a local authority;
    - (b) the authority is a local authority; and
    - (c) for the purpose of determining the allowance payable for meals, the provisions of paragraphs (b), (c) or (d) of Schedule 2 apply irrespective of the electoral ward that the member represents.
  - (1A) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (1C), the convenor of an authority shall be paid by that authority a total yearly amount equal to the yearly amount payable to a convenor of a joint board under regulation 12(8) of the Local Governance (Scotland) Act 2004 (Remuneration) Regulations 2007(3), under deduction of the amount payable to a Councillor under regulation 10 of those Regulations.
  - (1B) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (1C), the deputy convenor of an authority shall be paid a total yearly amount equal to the yearly amount payable to a vice-convenor of a joint board under regulation 12(9) of the Local Governance (Scotland) Act 2004 (Remuneration) Regulations 2007, under deduction of the amount payable to a Councillor under regulation 10 of those Regulations.
  - (1C) No remuneration shall be payable in terms of paragraphs (1A) and (1B) where the convenor or deputy convenor is in receipt of remuneration as a Senior Councillor under regulation 9 or as a convenor or vice-convenor of a joint board under regulation 12 of the Local Governance (Scotland) Act 2004 (Remuneration) Regulations 2007.".
